#### **Resources and Equipment**

The physical resources required for assessment of this competency requires access to:-

- a horse for personal use
- a suitable location with controlled conditions
- horses in a recreational or training program, housed in an appropriate private or commercial establishment
- horses which are quiet and reasonable tractable

The human resources which assess this unit of competency will require to be consistent with those outlined in the Supervisors/Assessors form and terms and conditions.

This is the practical assessment component for 2.H.02 Handling. It consists of three types of assessment Self, Peer and Trainer/Assessor.

The self assessment section is to be filled out by the student.

Peer assessors can be anyone with relevant horse experience (i.e. local riding club member, horse riding friend) and don't require to be registered with us.

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#### 2.H.02-Handling

Safely approach, catch, handle, lead and control horses?

Tie a horse up using a quick release knot?

During this activity did you/the trainee:-

- Use a halter and lead which was fitted and adjusted to the horse with all buckles /knots secured and strap ends through the keepers?
- Tie the horse to a piece of baling twine that was attached to a post?
- Tie the horse up short enough that it couldn't become entangled in the lead?
- Follow instructions or recognized procedure?
- Handle the horses in a manner appropriate to the situation/environment?
- Handle a range of horses in a variety of environments?
- Gather information about horses prior to approaching?
- Consider social behaviour and vices of horses to anticipate behaviour including senses, communication traits and behaviour patterns of horses while handling?
- Wear safe attire appropriate for handling horses (including enclosed footwear and sun protection)?
