Resources and Equipment

The physical resources required for assessment of this competency requires access to:

- a horse for personal use
- a suitable location with controlled conditions
- horses in a recreational or training program, housed in an appropriate private or commercial establishment
- horses which are quiet and reasonable tractable

The human resources which assess this unit of competency will require to be consistent with those outlined in the Supervisors/Assessors form and terms and conditions.

This is the practical assessment component for 3.R.21 Prepare for Lunging. It consists of three types of assessment Self, Peer and Trainer/Assessor. The self assessment section is to be filled out by the student.

Peer assessors can be anyone with relevant horse experience (i.e. local riding club member, horse riding friend) and don't require to be registered with us.

Can you prepare a horse for lunging and demonstrate fitting and adjusting:-

- cavesson?
- roller?
- side reins to a roller?
- side reins to a saddle?

During this practical activities do you:-

- Groom the horse including picking out hooves before fitting gear and equipment?
- Adjust the cavesson to fit firmly enough so that it will not twist when the horse is lunged?
- Select equipment appropriate to the size and training of the horse?
- Attach the lunge rein before attaching side reins?
- Secure the reins of the bridle in a fashion which will prevent them from becoming loose while lunging?
- Attach the outside side rein before attaching the inside?
- Give consideration to the horses' current level of education/training when determining the length of the side reins?
